The Ritual

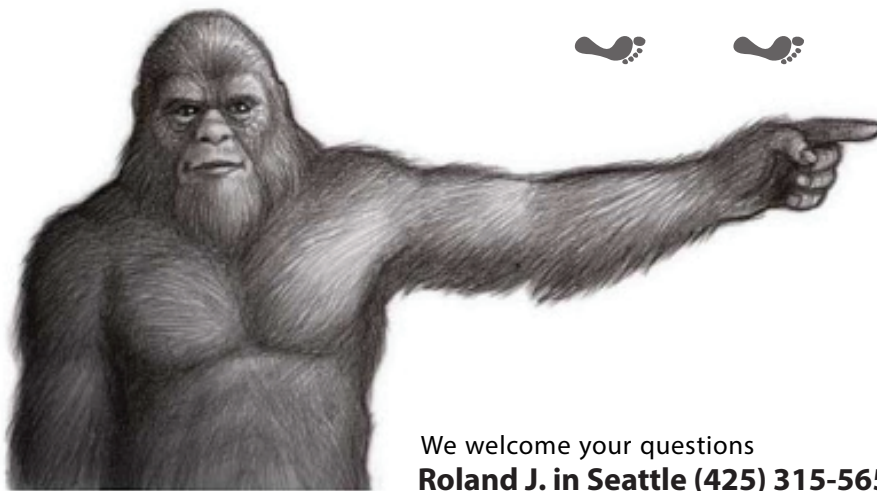
- Check in 2:00pm Friday June 23

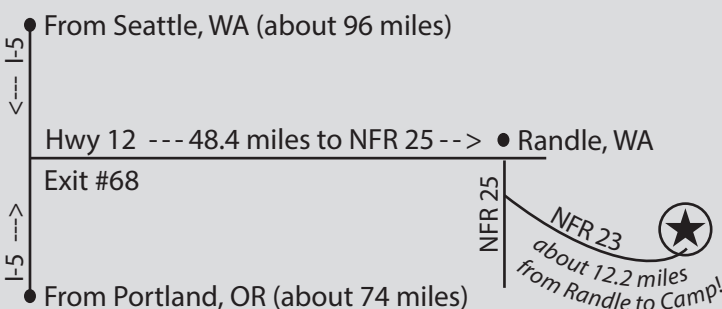

Directions from I-5:

- Take Exit #68, Hwy 12, East to Randle, WA. (48.4 miles)
- Turn right onto National Forest Road (NFR) 25, aka County Rd 9009/WA-131 (1 mile)
- Go left at "Y" onto NFR 23, aka Cispus Rd (10.8 miles)
- ⚙️ Slight left in to Camp! (0.4 miles)
